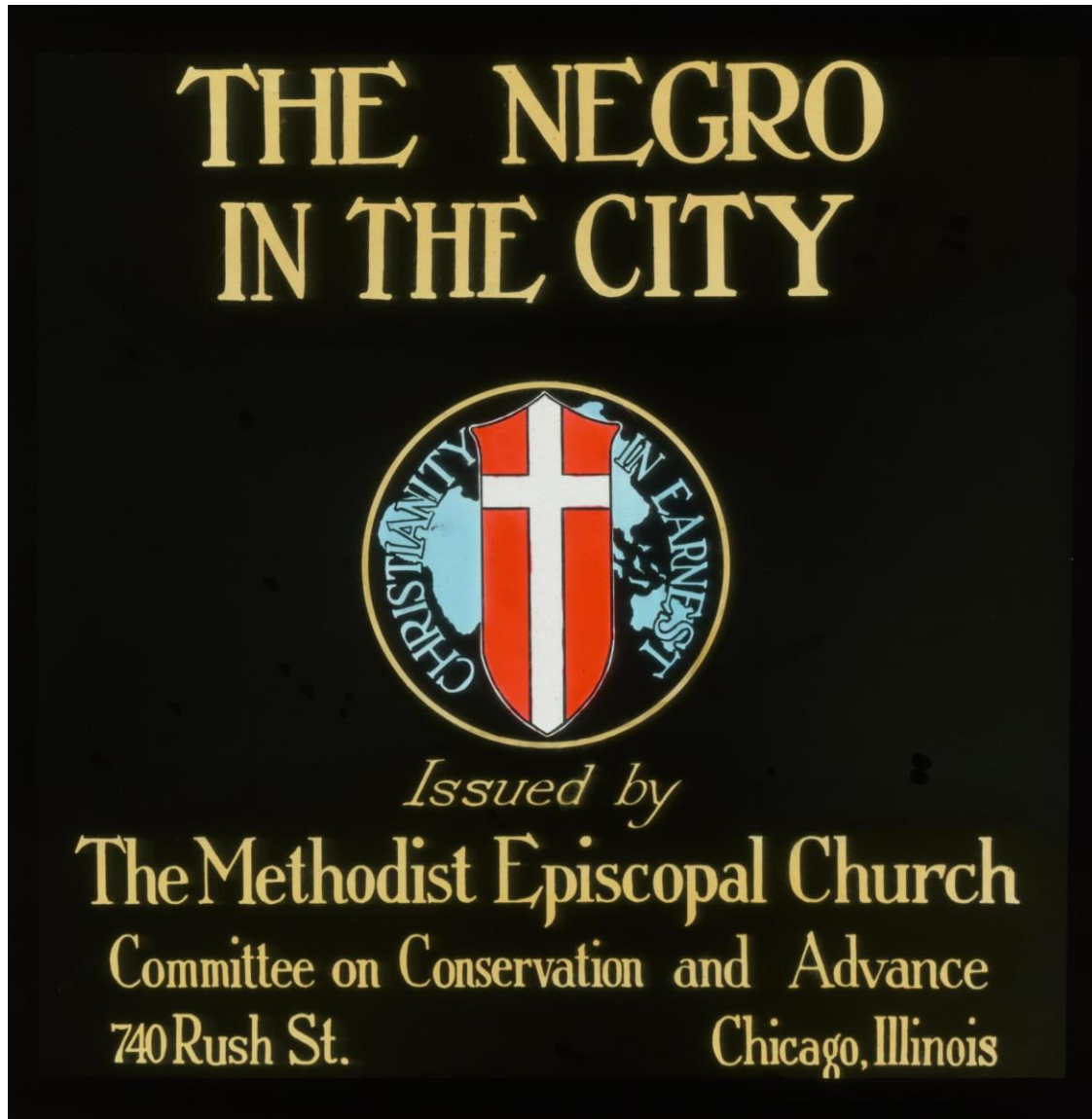


The Negro in the City, title card (1922)

METHODIST PROGRAM FOR CITY NEGRO CHURCH

The Program of the Methodist Episcopal Church for the city negro church is to

- 1. Train men as pastors of city churches**
- 2. Erect new church buildings in crowded sections**
- 3. Enlarge and adequately equip present churches**
- 4. Erect community house in every Negro district**
- 5. Give Sunday school facilities to every child**
- 6. Provide community workers and visiting nurses**
- 7. Promote clean athletics, recreation, reading room**
- 8. Provide industrial training, employment bureau**
- 9. Organize City Mission and Church Extension Societies**
- 10. Co-operate with other agencies influencing Negro life**
